### **Teaching Assistant (TA2)**

Predominantly this role will exist to support identified students with their learning experience throughout the school day. This will involve working alongside subject staff to plan and support work within the classroom which meets the needs of individual learners with SEN, including students of particular focus on our SEN register for: Cognition and Learning/Social, Mental and Emotional Health/Communication and Interaction/Sensory and / or Physical impairment.

The successful candidate will have a proven ability to relate well to both children and adults, be able to work constructively as part of a team and have a goal driven approach to solving problems.

32.5 hours per week, typically 8.30am – 3.40pm, Monday – Friday term time plus 5 staff learning days; 39 weeks per annum.
